Almost immediately, out of a powerful conviction that the music must play on, the Peterborough Folk Music Society sprang into life. It was spearheaded by Deb McWethy, founder and president of what is now Peterborough Folk Music.

On January 7, 1996, just seven days after the closing of The Folkway, the newly formed group held its first concert, featuring Dar Williams and Peter Mulvey—two of the many top musicians who have graced our stages over the past three decades.

The impact of Peterborough Folk Music on audiences, musicians, and our vibrant Monadnock region is profound. PFM has helped launch and sustain the careers of countless extraordinary musicians. It has built and sustained a deeply loyal and grateful audience of listeners, who come for the first time or the hundredth time and become part of this deep and ever-changing tradition.

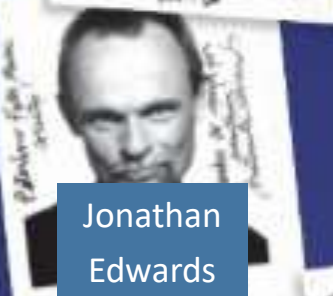
